Existence of Institutional Mechanisms to promote gender equality





What have we achieved?

1. Enhanced capacity on gender and GRB

- A critical minimum mass; New constituency
- But what is the strategy?

2. Gender Budget Statements— a step towards more transparency?

- "We cant see gender in the budget"; Important consciousness
- But being done more like a checklist; weak gender analysis and weak monitoring

3. Contributions to the gender architecture

• Who monitors? Who convenes? Do they actually sit in on budget decision?

4. Changing policies and budget

- Changes in the distribution of benefits among beneficiaries
- Introduction of new policy and funding
