## GOLD-STANDARD DEGREE PREPARATION

A Levels are the gold standard for entry to UK universities, including Oxford, Cambridge and Imperial College. A Levels usually take 2 years but Bellerbys College also provides an intensive 15-month course starting in April, allowing access to university in September the following year.
