International Foundation Joint Venture scholarships - science pathways

For students commencing the International Foundation science pathways (General Science; Pharmacy, Biomedicine and Health; and Engineering, Physical Sciences and Mathematics) in January 2015, INTO and the University of East Anglia are offering two 50% scholarships.

International Foundation Centre Director scholarship - science pathways

For students commencing the International Foundation science pathways (General Science; Pharmacy, Biomedicine and Health; and Engineering, Physical Sciences and Mathematics) in January 2015, the Centre is offering one Centre Director scholarship valued at 25% of the full tuition fee.
