## 2014 Wah Seong Penang Chess League Team Tournament

Red Rock Hotel • 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> Dec 2014

### Tournament Regulations

- This is a team tournament, open to all players.
- The tournament format is a 7-round Swiss System played under the Laws of Chess of the World Chess Federation (FIDE) and the following supplementary rules.
- For the pairings, a Swiss Manager program will be used and paired according to Match Points (2,1,0)
- The tournament is open to teams from these four broad categories: Public Sector (government and quasi-government departments), Factories, Institutions of Learning (schools, colleges & universities) and Others (companies, firms, registered societies/ clubs). Each team shall represent an organization in any of the above categories and only their bona fide employees, members or students can be registered in the team.
- Each team is allowed to include one guest player
- Each team shall comprise a minimum of four and a maximum of five players, with any four players to play in every round.
- The average players rating (MCF Chess Rating) during play should be less than 2000.
- A player with FIDE rating but no MCF Rating can register with FIDE rating minus 200 points. Foreign unrated players (No FIDE rating and No MCF rating) will be considered as 1800 and local players as 1500 for calculation purposes
- Each player is accorded a time control of 60 minutes (1 hour) to complete the game.
- Recording of move is compulsory for all players until the last 5 minutes. [1st offence: 5 minutes deducted and updating of scoresheet; 2nd offence: Loss of game.]
- There will be no sharing of prizes. The following tie-breaks will be used: (a) MATCH points (b) Game points (c) Solkoff.
- The online registration board order ([penangchess.com](http://penangchess.com) website) will be the final board order. Changing of board order at Round 0 is not allowed.
- FIDE regulations apply for mobile phones – a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone and/or other electronic means of communication in the playing venue. Penalty is the automatic loss of the game.
