
Opening Song: All Creatures of Our God and King (G.14 SYPTG)

DIALOGUE:



A family is having a discussion on the above pictures.

Son : Dad, why is everyone carrying a cross?

Dad : Yes, everyone of us has a cross to carry.

Daughter: Dad, that cross looks so heavy. I think he is going to cut off part the cross to make it lighter to carry.

Mom : Look! He has reached a ravine and is unable to place his cross over the ravine as his cross is too short. Others can use their crosses to walk over to the other side.

: It is important to face our difficulties even though it can be very hard at times. The little pains that we go through in our daily lives help to build our strength, grow in maturity and deepen our relationship with God.

Yes children, your dad is right. Sometimes I too complain when difficulties come my way. I too feel like I want to cut off part of my cross ---like the man in the picture. However, when I turn to God in prayer, I feel strengthened and I find solutions to my difficulties. God always helps me to find a way and I am grateful to Him.

DISCERNMENT

Biblical text: Rom 5:1-5

1. Ask the Holy Spirit

(for openness to encounter Christ and to be encountered by Christ ...)

- 2. Read the text two or three times (or use *drawings*, *pictures*, *role play*, *video* ...)
- 3. Be in silence with the text
- 4. What words or phrases caught my attention?
- 5. What is the Holy Spirit saying to me?

DEEDS

- a) Share in small groups(3-4 persons) on points # 4 + 5
- b) Share 2 or 3 main points with all present
- c) Facilitator guides members in deciding on ONE task to be carried out as a BEC/community (Note: May need to pause if it is difficult to arrive at ONE common task)
- **d)** Facilitator helps the BEC/community with details of the chosen task that will bring a sense of hope to others
- e) Time of prayer
 (for the needs of persons in the BEC/community, country and the task that has been decided ...)

Note to facilitator

- i) Use creative/alternative/participative ways in facilitating
- ii) Keep in mind the theme; what transpired in the Dialogue and Discernment portion of the guide
- iii) Keep in mind the 4E approach; Encountered, Empowered, Enlightened, Evangelising
- iv) You are free to facilitate the **3D(Dialogue, Discernment, Deeds)** process so that it is relevant and meaningful for the BEC/community gathering
