## **SYNOPSIS OF MODULES**

### **MODULE 1: FAITH AND REVELATION**

"Theological understanding is not a theory or invention, something wafted into existence by the theologian's magic wand. It names a dimension of the life of faith itself, the understanding required of faith as it exists in various life contexts..." - Edward Farley. This course invites the participant to develop a methodological understanding of the praxis of theological reflection considering the relation of revelation, tradition, faith, reason and authority.
