# SINGAPORE DANCE THEATRE PRESENTS BALLET ILLUMINATIONS MALAYSIA TOUR

# 16 & 17 MAY, PENANG PERFORMING ARTS CENTRE

Singapore Dance Theatre will return to Malaysia this May to share their love and passion for dance with the Malaysian audience, through *Ballet Illuminations*. After four consecutive years of successful performances at Kuala Lumpur Performing Arts Centre (klpac), SDT has been invited back to present a selection of classical and contemporary favourites from the repertoire, with two additional performances for the first time at Performance Arts Centre of Penang (penangpac). *Ballet Illuminations* (penangpac) is a joint collaboration between Singapore Dance Theatre and penangpac.

SDT will perform in stage 1 at penangpac on 16 and 17 May (Friday and Saturday) at 8.30pm. This performance is made possible with the support of YTL Corporation Berhad, National Arts Council, Singapore and penangpac. SDT will also be performing at the Kuala Lumpur Performing Arts Centre (klpac) from 9 - 11 May.

*Ballet Illuminations* will feature a medley of diverse and exquisite works by award-winning choreographers, showcasing the finest examples of choreography to the Malaysian audience. The performance line up includes stunning works of choreography by world-renowned choreographers in the likes of George Balanchine, Japanese choreographer Toru Shimazaki and Dutch choreographer Nils Christe. The annual *Ballet Illuminations* is a perfect display of versatility and talent that is synonymous with SDT's unique identity as a company that is equally adept at these challenging and varied genres of dance.

Artistic Director of Singapore Dance Theatre, Janek Schergen comments, "Singapore Dance Theatre has entered a new phase of artistic achievement with the completion of 25 years of history in 2013. Beginning this season, we can call upon a significant body of repertory to shape our performances artistically. This also marks the 5<sup>th</sup> year of our annual visits to Malaysia so our audiences there have had an opportunity to appreciate the various facets of our dancers and choreographic offerings through SDT's *Ballet Illuminations*. This year's offerings include George Balanchine's *Allegro Brillante*, Toru Shimazaki's creation for SDT, *Absence of Story*, Nils Christe's *ZIN*! and Don Quixote pas de deux, showing SDT at our diverse best on stage. Coming to Malaysia has become one of the highlights of our performance year."

Be captivated as Singapore Dance Theatre brings to the stage a fine mix of classical and contemporary ballet at this year's *Ballet Illuminations*!

### Allegro Brillante by George Balanchine

Choreographed in 1956, *Allegro Brillante* by George Balanchine demonstrates the dramatic possibilities inherent in pure dance when coupled with the Russian romanticism of Tchaikovsky's score. The music's vigorous pace makes the steps appear even more difficult, but the ballet relies on strong dancing, precise timing, and breadth of gesture. Balanchine once said of the ballet, "It contains everything I know about the classical ballet in 13 minutes."

### Don Quixote pas de deux

The third-act grand pas de deux from *Don Quixote* is one of ballet's most spectacular variations. This excerpt includes the thrilling boy-versus-girl coda in which Kitri whips off her famous 32 fouettes. The pas de deux features choreography after Marius Petipa and is danced to music by Ludwig Minkus.

#### Absence of Story by Toru Shimazaki

Toru's initial concept for this piece was to create a visual array of movements to accompany the music of Brahms. This particular piece of music is so powerful that he simply wanted to react honestly to it. *Absence of Story* is danced to the music of Brahms, and is a stirring piece without story or words in hope of not causing distraction to the beauty and the power of music. Toru Shimazaki is the chief professor of the dance department at Kobe College and has created works for many international companies including Hubbard Street Dance Chicago, The Royal Flanders Ballet, Polish Dance Theatre, Colorado Ballet, Grand Theatre de Geneve and Introdans.

#### ZIN! by Nils Christe

Featuring a cast of seven dancers, *ZIN*! by Nils Christe is an upbeat and lively piece that is bubbling with humour. Danced to the music of Serra Pelada from the album Powaqqatsi by Philip Glass, the dance explores the use of canon and repetition. Both quirky and playful, *ZIN*! was a huge hit at the company premiere during Ballet Under the Stars in 2012. This piece will most definitely amuse and entertain, teasing smiles and laughter from the audience. *ZIN*! was created for Introdans and was first performed in 1997.

# THE COMPANY

SDT was founded in 1988 by Goh Soo Khim and Anthony Then. Since then, SDT has developed into Singapore's premier professional dance company comprising 37 dancers. In the course of each year, the Company performs six main seasons, including the widely popular *Ballet Under The Stars* at the Fort Canning Park, two full length classics, *Masterpiece in Motion* which brings together three works of the finest international choreography and *Passages* Contemporary Season.

As an ambassador for dance and for Singapore, the company aims to be an internationally well-regarded professional dance company that is known for its unique ability to shine in classical, neo-classical and contemporary repertoire with works that are timeless and inspiring.

The Company's repertoire ranges from classical to contemporary ballet, from renowned choreographers like Goh Choo San, George Balanchine, Nacho Duato, Jiri Kylian, Stanton Welch, Marie-Claude Pietragalla, Xing Liang, Natalie Weir, Val Caniparoli, Graham Lustig, David Dawson, Jorma Elo, Edmund Stripe, Adrian Burnett, Edwaard Liang, Nils Christe, Toru Shimazaki and Christina Chan.

In 2008, Janek Schergen was appointed Artistic Director of SDT. Under his leadership, the Company has made new achievements in the international and Singapore dance arena. In the last six years, the Company has added 16 world premieres and 12 company premieres to the repertoire, in addition to numerous revivals of the existing Company's repertoire. Janek is also the Artistic Director of the Choo-San Goh & H. Robert Magee Foundation which oversees the licensing and production of Choo San Goh's ballets and the annual Choo San Goh Awards for Choreography.

SDT actively reaches out to the public to create greater awareness of dance through outreach to schools with its Arts Education Programme, Dance Appreciation Series (jointly presented with Esplanade Co.), Adults Dance Classes, Scholars Programme for students considering dancing as a career, *Passages* choreographic workshop focusing on local emerging talents and One @ The Ballet, an initiative to help the public gain a better understanding of the different aspects of dance.

In 2013, SDT moved to a new premise with four state of the art studios. Additionally the Company will be enhancing efforts in Education and Outreach, bringing greater awareness and appreciation for dance to a wider audience.
